There is an ongoing need for nurses across the Roseburg VA Healthcare System due to attrition rates and growth.

#### Associated Health Trainees

VHA Handbook 1400.04 Supervision of Associated Health Trainees

"academic institutions seeking to affiliate with VA medical facilities for associated health clinical education experiences must have (or be actively seeking) programmatic accreditation from an accrediting body officially recognized by the U.S. Department of Education or the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA)".



### VA Nurse Qualification Standards

The VA Handbook 5005/27 Staffing, Section B, Nurse Qualification Standard, requires:

"a Graduate of professional nursing approved by the appropriate state agency and accredited by one of the following accrediting bodies at the time the program was completed by the applicant. 1. The National League for Nursing Accrediting Commission (NLNAC). 2. The Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE)".



- In nursing, the purpose of accreditation is to ensure that nursing education programs across the United States are being held to common standards of quality.
- National Accreditation is the standard that the VA requires to ensure that a nurse educated in Massachusetts and a nurse educated in California are able to perform their duties with the same level of competence.



## National Accreditation Requirements

- VHA National Directive and policies prohibits an Academic Affiliation Agreement with UCC's Nursing Program therefore disqualifying clinical rotations of their nursing students.
- Graduates from the UCC RN program are disqualified for employment in the Roseburg VA Health Care System as well as the VA's and other Federal Agencies across the Nation.



## National Accreditation Requirements

- Lack of a local Nationally Accredited Nursing Program greatly impacts the Roseburg VA's capability to hire local nurses and ultimately affects the care of Roseburg Veterans.
- Currently the Roseburg VA employs ninety-eight RN's which are UCC Nursing Program Graduates. Thirty-four of those graduates were hired over the past 5 years.

\*These numbers do not account for nurses who were hired from UCC and have since transferred to another VA Health Care System or other Private Health Care facility such as Mercy Medical Center.
